Personal Data We Collect

We only collect data that helps us achieve the purpose set out in this Privacy Policy. We will not collect any additional data beyond the data listed below without notifying you first.

Data Collected Automatically

When you visit and use our Site, we may automatically collect and store the following information: IP addresses, browser types, device type, pages viewed, approximate geolocation, network used, how often you visit our site and session statistics.

Data Collected in a Non-Automatic Way

We may also collect the following data when you perform certain functions on our Site: First and last name, Email address, and Phone number.

This data may be collected using the following methods: Filling out Contact Form.

How We Use Personal Data

Data collected on our Site will only be used for the purposes specified in this Privacy Policy or indicated on the relevant pages of our Site. We will not use your data beyond what we disclose in this Privacy Policy.

The data we collect automatically is used for the following purposes: Analytics.

The data we collect when the user performs certain functions such as filling out forms) may be used for the following purposes: Responding to inquiries.

Who We Share Personal Data With

Employees

We may disclose user data to any member of our organization who reasonably needs access to user data to achieve the purposes set out in this Privacy Policy.

Third Parties

The following third parties automatically collect user data: Youtube.

We will not sell or share your data with other third parties, except in the following cases:

How Long We Store Personal Data

User data collected by the first party will be stored until the purpose the data was collected for has been achieved, or for a maximum of two (2) years.

Children

Cookie Policy
