ANSWERS TO THE APRIL'S QUIZ

What are the significance of the following dates: April 2, 1888; according to our history records is the formal beginning of Grace.

On August 6, 1916, there was a special service for the laying of the cornerstone of the church that burned down.

September 28, 1952; following the special morning service, they laid the cornerstone of the new church hall (it housed the chapel, pastor's office, kitchen, and Fellowship Hall, Church office, furnace room and a Sunday School room in the basement.

May 29, 1994 is the first Sunday we were in our new building after the fire.

August 1, 2019, was Pastor Ralph's first Sunday here at Grace. How old is our congregation on April 2, 2024? We are 136 years old.

We have been having a great time at Sunday School this



spring!! It was so nice to see those who came for our Palm Sunday Service and our first skating event with 45 on the ice!! Hot chocolate was enjoyed by all the children afterwards. Check out our church's website where pictures are posted.
