

In this issue, here are some highlights from the Synod Convention which was held on June 20 thru June 22. As

with all conventions, the days were long, starting at 9am and running through to 9pm. Most of the discussions were around voting new members for Synod office and a new Bishop. As you know Bishop Michael will be retiring from his call this fall. There were 4 candidates who were nominated. During the first two ballots, all rostered members were also eligible to be nominated from the floor. The first ballot there was 19 who received a vote, and NO, I was not one of them. It took 5 ballots in all to finally elect a new Bishop. Her name is The Rev. Carla Blakley from Saskatchewan. She won by one vote over the Rev. Adam Snook. Bishop-elect Rev. Carla will be ordained at the end of September. We heard from various speakers giving updates from their respective groups. One item that was discussed of some importance was a Motion to limited the term for a Bishop to two 6 year term, this was defeated. The morning worships were inspiring and prepared us for the day.
