From the Pastor's Desk



The Advent season is a four week period of preparation for the coming of Jesus Christ. The origin of "advent" is from the Latin word *adventus* which simply translates "coming" or "arrival". Not only is the Christian meaning for preparation and

celebration of the coming of Jesus Christ, his birth at Christmas, but also to celebrate the new life when someone accepts Jesus Christ as their Savior, and lastly, the anticipation of Jesus returning again. The color of blue is used in our paraments and vestments, as a symbol of hope and of our waiting. There are beautiful and rich traditions behind the celebration of Advent. The four Sundays of Advent each have a specific theme or focus (Hope, Love, Joy, Peace) The purpose of each theme is to spend time reflecting on the true meaning of the season - the life of Jesus Christ and in the preparation and waiting for his coming. The goal should be to come before God with a sincere heart and to faithfully worship Jesus Christ.

May you find time to slow down this Christmas season, say "no" to the things that distract you from Jesus and say "yes" to the gift that God wants you to experience. Ellen and I would like to thank you all for your support this past year and may you have a Blessed Advent season and a Happy Christmas.
